Maths

This week for maths we are consolidating what we have learnt over the term. We will be looking at height, distance, subtracting and adding.



Monday - HWe are adding groups of objects this week. have bowls with a different number of objects in each. Encourage your child to add the first bowl then the second. Ask them how many there are altogether. Encourage your child to add another different amount each time. (have no more than 8 objects in each bowl)

Tuesday - Explain to the children that we are continuing to add two groups of the objects together. Recap what happens when you add 2 amounts. Give your child pens and paper. Play

Thursday - Explain to your child that we are still working on addition. Recap by showing a line of two different types of fruits (or two different types of objects will be sufficient). Tell your child to tell you how many of a certain fruit there are. Encourage them to write the number. ask your child to count the number of the other fruit and write the number. Ask them to add both the numbers together. Do a few more together with a different number of fruits each time.

Literacy

Our learning intention will be to talk about our transition to Reception..

LS: In Reception, I would like to... I am excited for... I am worried about...

Monday - Explain to the children that our Nursery year is coming to an end, and we are thinking about moving to Reception in September. Tell the children that we are going to make a list of all the things we are excited about moving to Reception for. Have a discussion about what things your children are excited about and make a list.

Tuesday - Recap with children the things they were excited for in Reception next year. Then explain to the children that this is a period of transition and change - and sometimes we might feel nervous or unsure about what is to come. Encourage children to think if there is anything they are worried about in regards to moving to Reception. Then, think of what we can do to help with those worried feelings.

Wednesday - Draw a self portrait. Use this as the start of a small fact file to make that you can give to your new teacher so they know all about you! Draw a picture of your face, and write your name at the top. To extend, have a go at writing the sentence - my name is...

Thursday - Today we are going to add to our self portrait fact file. Think about 5 things that you like - they could be food, games, toys, people, anything. Draw pictures of them on your self-portrait page. Extend by either labelling or writing a sentence (with support) saying one thing that you like. E.g I like pizza.
