Maths

Our maths focus this week will be finding out 1 less than a number!

Key vocabulary - more, bigger, number line, adding

Monday - Listen to and sing number songs together. <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=D0Aiq682yrA>

Tuesday - Random Dice: <https://www.online-stopwatch.com/chance-games/roll-a-dice/>

Recap on yesterday's lesson! Sing along to the number song again and this time try and count from 1-20 without looking at the numbers on the screen. Take on a challenge, I'm sure you will do great!

Use the dice to see how many objects you will add to a box! If you don't have a box at home you can use a container or a jug. Count the number of objects and show this with your fingers. Find out how many there are if you take one away. You can use a sentence starter to help you speak in a full sentence!

Sentence starter: 1 less than ____ is ____.

Wednesday - Today ask an adult to help you draw a number line and add the numbers on it. Can you jump one less than the number? or why don't you clap the numbers? To challenge yourself, can you use the number line and make 2 jumps less?

Thursday - As part of our Spanish lessons we have been learning how to count in Spanish! Join us by listening to this song - <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=zzhHrQbHZMA> Do you remember how to say numbers from 1-5 in Spanish?

Friday - Recap on whole weeks learning on 1 less than a number. Find objects in your house and play a game with your family. Place the objects on the floor and ask your family members to write what one less than the number of objects is. Take turns so you get a chance to join in too!

Extra activities

1. Continue practising number formation.
2. Practice counting from 1-20 - You can use the number song to support your child and also hide the numbers so your child independently counts from 1-20.

3. Practice finding out 1 more of an object or number at home.
4. Draw a number line with your child and get them to point to numbers.

Daily Phonics

This week we will be recapping some sounds we have already learned - m, a, s, d, t.

Literacy

Our **learning intention will be to label parts of a superhero..** You can do these activities over the course of the week.

Key vocab: superheroes, super powers, costume, boots, cape, fast, strong, flying, mask, invisible, rescue

Sentence starter - I can.... I think... superheroes are...

Mon - Have a class discussion about what Superheroes children know. Introduce the book for the lesson and read 'Super Ben' with all the children in class.

Tuesday - Recap yesterday's lesson on the book. Talk about what Superheroes wear and children get to design their own Superheroes. Talk about specific clothes or props children wear (mask, pants, boots, cape)

Wed - Now that we have thought about what Superheroes wear and children got a chance to design their own Superheroes. Children get a chance to draw their own superheroes. Think about questions like: What is Super Ben wearing? What do Superheroes wear? Use the Super Ben book to support children draw on paper. Children get to colour in their drawing at the end!

Thurs - Today children get a chance to think about superhero powers! We will have a class discussion about all the different types of superheroes and children get a chance to add a superhero power for their own superhero.

Friday - let's role play! Now that we have thought about our Superheroes and their powers, collect some items from around your home that you can use to role play being that superhero. Have fun!

Topic



Creative - Use some food scraps to make your own paint. Some ideas can be found in the picture.

Understanding the World - In our classroom we will be sorting rubbish and talking about the similarities between metal, plastic and card. At home you can ask your child to help you sort out the recycling and have similar conversations about the similarities and differences.
