This homework project is for the whole family to get involved with and we would encourage children to get help completing any of the activities.

Write a poem about Easter.	Design your own Easter basket.	Create a of Spring collage - think of the weather and changes in nature during this time and express it in your picture.	Challenge your family members to a dance-a-thon! See who can dance for the longest amount of time in your family.
Go for a walk in a local park. Make sure you walk at a steady pace for at least 30mins. Keep a walking diary to record how many times you can do this healthy activity during the break.	Create a Sugar Smart recipe for the Osmani Sugar Smart Junior Chef cooking competition. Take pictures, record the recipe and email it to your class email.	Write a short story or poem for this years writing competition - on the theme 'I Am Not Alone'.	Make a 3D model of Osmani school. Add the outdoor features to challenge yourself e.g. play areas, flowerbeds or benches.
Draw a self portrait and then cut out different features of your face. Then re-arrange them to create a new portrait, using your previous learning, in the style of Picasso.	Create art using 2D shapes. Use 2D shapes to create everyday objects, food or vehicles.	Record how many different ways you help your parents during the break. Then use this data to create a simple tally chart table presenting your data. Can you identify the most popular and least popular activities?	Create a thank you card for someone who helps and supports you. Include a kind message to show them your appreciation.
Play a board game with your family.	Create flowers using origami and create a Spring flower basket. Write down your dreams and hopes on the petals of the flowers.	Create a kindness treasure hunt around your home. Leave kind messages for loved ones to find in different places around your home and surprise them! Example: a message for mum on her pillow, a message for dad under a tissue box etc.	Choose a favourite author and create a fact file about them. Find out about: -where they live -who inspired them -what books they have written -anyof their favourite people or places -what inspires them.
