For this project homework, can you please select one or more activities below and complete them. You will present what you have found out to the rest of your class. Please ask for whatever paper you need from your teacher during the homework project.

This homework project is for the whole family to get involved with and we would encourage children to get help completing any of the activities.

Make your own water wheel using recyclable items found around your home. Draw a model of your wheel and annotate it.	Design an Anglo-Saxon brooch according to the patterns and designs used by the Anglo-Saxons.
Research King Alfred the Great and his role in British history.	Research town and city names in the UK. Try to identify which towns and cities have kept their Anglo-Saxon name origins. Mark these on a map of the UK.
Design and build your own Anglo-Saxon longship. Use what you have learned about their boats to help you as well as recyclable materials.	Write a diary entry from the point of view of an Anglo Saxon settler at the time of the Viking invasion.
Write your own Myth & Legend story, set in Scandinavia. Think of the 5 parts that make a myth or legend. Use your knowledge of Beowulf to help you.	Write a non-chronological report about the different Anglo-Saxon and Viking gods and goddesses.
