Each week can you please select one of the activities below and complete them. You will present what you have found out to the rest of your class. Please ask for whatever paper you need from your teacher during the homework project.

This homework project is for the whole family to get involved with and we would encourage children to get help completing any of the activities.

Write a poem about deforestation, global warming and the greenhouse gases.	Design a poster about the effects of deforestation to our planet.
Make a rainforest using junk material or create a collage of a rainforest.	Paint your very own flower (take a look at Georgia O'Keeffe's flower paintings for ideas).
Design a poster based on the types of animals and plants you will find in a forest.	Draw/create a flower and label the different parts and their function. Then create a design of your own flower and label its features.
Draw a sequence of pictures of the process of pollination / seed protection flowering plants.	Draw a world map and locate the five main places where rainforest habitats are located. Write down facts about the different rainforests.
Create a fact file and write a list of ten common animals/insects/trees found in rainforests.	Use a variety of recycled, natural and man-made materials to make 3D artworks based on rainforests and plants etc.

Free choice: Pick a project of your own to complete. Remember it has to relate to our topic 'Into the Forest'.
