

Nursery Weekly Homework Week Beginning 1.6.20

Hello Everyone!

Welcome back to our final term this academic year. We hope that you are all doing well and enjoying the lovely weather. We have a lot of fun and exciting activities planned for you this term that we hope you will enjoy. This week we'll be reading one of Nursery Red's favourite stories Shark in the Park.

Maths

Our maths focus this week will be sorting objects into 2 groups. Feel free to adapt the activities based on the resources you have at home (you can use toys, scarves, colouring pencils etc). The maths activity can be repeated daily with different objects and in different contexts.



Activity - choose some objects from around the home that share some similarities and differences that your child would be able to identify e.g. a group of toys made from different materials and with some similar features. Put them in a pile and let your child know that you want to sort them into 2 groups. Tell your child what those two groups are going to be 'I'm going to sort these into soft toys and hard toys'. Begin sorting them and then ask your child to help you. If your child is able to sort them quite easily you can ask them to sort the objects in a different way

(by colour, size, shape). If your child is finding this activity tricky you can support them by thinking out loud and talking about why you are sorting the object the way you are. Repeat the activity everyday in real life activities like tidying up, putting away plates, clothes etc.



Ext: ask your child to count how many of each object there is in each group and write the number on a piece of paper.

Literacy

Our story this week is [Shark in the Park](#). Watch the video to listen to the story. When the story is finished there are some questions your child can answer about what they heard. If they are unsure of the answer, rewind back to the part of the story where the answer can be found and encourage them to use the image to help them answer the question.



Our focus this week is going to be hearing and writing initial sounds. Show your children different parts of the story and talk about the different things that they can see in the park. Together write a list of what you see. Encourage your child to speak in full sentences ('I can see a...'). Repeat your child's sentence emphasising the thing they saw at the park e.g I can see a SLIDE. Ask your child if they can hear the first sound in the word. Support them by saying the word slowly and emphasising the first sound. Together write the first sound in the word.

You can do a few words a day during the week and then find time to take your child to your local park and see if you can find the things on your list.

Topic

Make a telescope - Timothy Pope used a telescope to look at things in the park. Use card and toilet rolls to make your own telescope. You can decorate it too using whatever you have at home. Take a trip to the park, what can you see through your telescope?

Draw your dream park - Take your colouring pencils and some paper to the park with you. Draw what you see. If you can't go to the park, have a think about what you would like to have in your park.

Make a shark costume - what features do sharks have? what will you use to help you make them?
