Using Kiddle- research Theism/Atheism and Agnostic and create a fact file	Create a poster about God (You cannot draw God) Use what you know God is not to explain what God is like. Example: God is not cruel (this suggests God is kind) God is not greedy (suggests he is giving)	Christians and Muslims believe God's existence can be proven by nature. Go out to the park, your garden or find items in your kitchen that you think are absolute proof that God exists. Create a collage using these items or pictures of these items.
