# **Vertebrates**

Animals can be classified as either vertebrates or invertebrates.

Vertebrates are animals that have a backbone inside their body. The major groups include fish, amphibians, reptiles, birds and mammals.

Invertebrates don't have a backbone. They either have a soft body, like worms and jellyfish, or a hard outer casing covering their body, like spiders and crabs.



# Make Your Own Identity Card



1. ALWAYS CARRY YOUR IDENTITY CARD

You may be required to produce it on demand to a Police Officer or member H.M. Armed Forces.

2. YOU ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR THIS CARD AND MUST NOT PART WITH IT TO ANY OTHER PERSON

You must report at once to the local National Registration Office if it is lost, destroyed, damaged or defaced.

- 3. If you find a lost Identity Card or have in your possession a card not belonging to yourself or anyone in your charge, you must hand it in at once at a Police Station or National Registration Office.
- 4. Any breach of these requirements is an offence punishable by a fine or imprisonment or both.
